- Striving to resolve complaints and recommending appropriate actions to the employer.

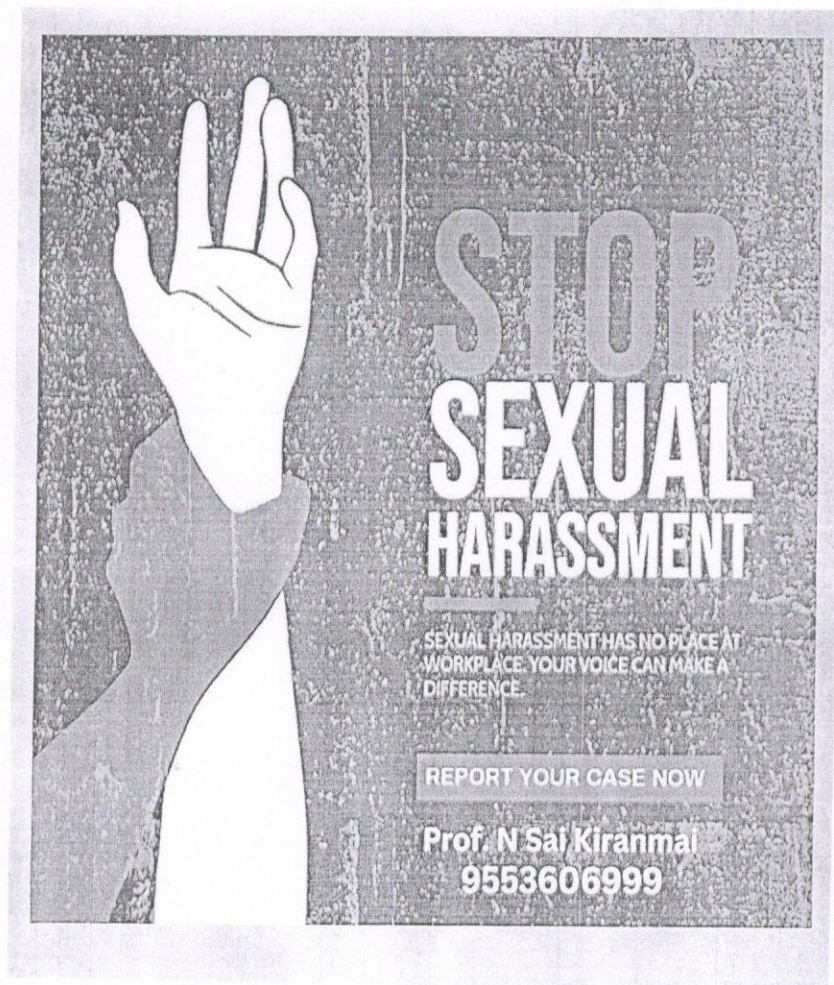
