- **Credit Distribution:** The discussion included adjusting credit distribution to give students more flexibility and giving emphasis to industrial relevant subjects.
- Practical Experience: Members suggested for effective conduction of Skill Development Courses, internships, projects to enhance the application of knowledge to address the societal and industrial needs/problem.
- **Elective Courses:** Members recommended adding elective course (V semester onwards) relevance to industry and advancements in Civil Engineering.
- Dr. V. Padmavathi, Professor of Civil Engineering and University Nominee, suggested shifting the Computational Lab / IoT Lab to B.Tech VI Semester and offering the Project Management Software Lab in VII Semester, as the Construction Planning and Management theory course is included as Professional Elective–IV in the VII Semester.
- Dr. P. N. Rao suggested removing the Computational Mathematics Lab from the III Semester
 and adjusting its credits by adding tutorial hours to the Strength of Materials theory course
 in the same Semester, He also recommended including the Conjugate Beam Method in UnitIV of the same course.
- Dr. P. N. Rao suggested removing the Building Information Modelling Lab from the V Semester and adjusting its credits by adding tutorial hours to the Design of Reinforced Concrete Members theory course in the same Semester.
- Dr. M. Heeralal, Professor at NIT Warangal suggested removing the Civil Engineering Software Lab from the VI Semester and adjusting its credits by adding tutorial hours to the Design of Steel Structures theory course in the same Semester.
- Dr. M. Heeralal, Professor at NIT Warangal, suggested shifting the Industrial Waste Water
 Treatment theory course to Professional Elective-I and the Remote Sensing & GIS theory
 course to Professional Elective-II, since the GIS Lab is already offered in the VI Semester.
- Mr. Mohammed Irfan Hussain, Industry Representative, suggested organizing Industrial
 Visits to construction sites, irrigation projects, water/wastewater treatment plants, cement
 & steel industries, and surveying projects to give students practical exposure and help
