- 3. Gather and record all relevant information, documents
- 4. Determine the main issues.
- 5. Create an enabling meeting environment
- 6. Use body language that communicates complete attention to the parties.
- 7. Treat the complaint with respect.
- 8. Discard pre-determined ideas.
- 9. Determine the harm.
