<b>Brief Report:</b>	<b>Blood Donation Camp Report</b>  The Blood Donation Camp was organized by the Social Service Club of Narsimha Reddy Engineering College in association with MNJ Institute of Oncology & Regional Cancer Centre on 2nd March 2026 at the 2nd Floor, MT Block on the account of Trishul Reddy and Trilok Reddy birthday. The event commenced at 10:00 AM with the objective of promoting voluntary blood donation and creating awareness about its life-saving impact.  The programme began with the registration of participants through a QR-based system, followed by preliminary health check-ups conducted by the medical team. Students, faculty, and staff actively participated in the camp, demonstrating a strong sense of social responsibility and humanitarian concern.  The event was successfully coordinated under the guidance of Prof. G. Shailaja Reddy (Convener) and Mr. M. Dhanush (Student Coordinator). The medical professionals from MNJ Institute ensured

that all safety protocols and hygienic practices were strictly followed throughout the blood donation process.

A significant number of donors enthusiastically contributed, resulting in the successful collection of 125 units of blood. Donors were provided with refreshments and proper post-donation care to ensure their well-being.

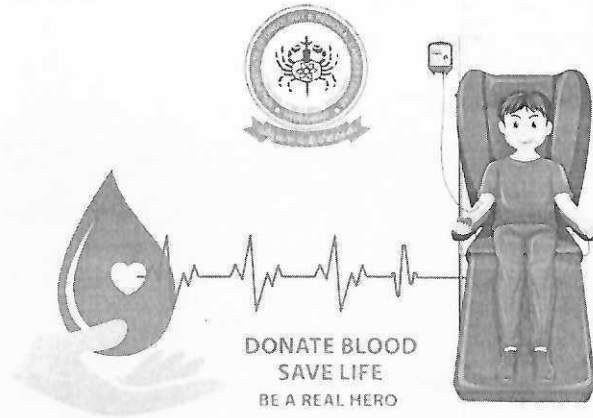

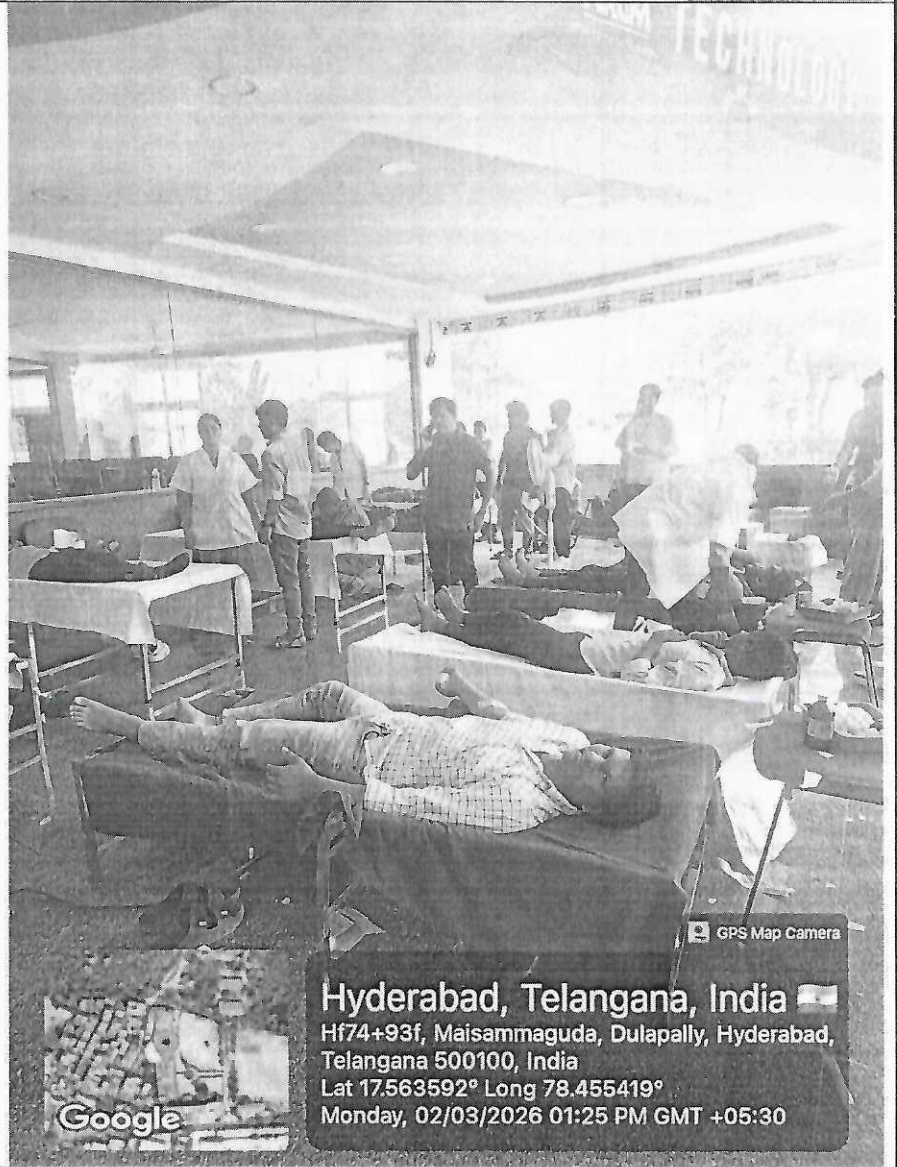
